Ambulance/Equipment Competency 102 - Practice

Activity Goal

To have Learner(s) practice finding and retrieving equipment based off the service's ambulance checklist.

* Completion requires documentation of hours by Mentor *

Activity Location:

Station/base

Equipment/Resources Needed:

- 1 service-ready ambulance
- Service's ambulance checklist

Set-Up

To set up for this activity, you will need at least 1 Mentor and 1 Learner at the ambulance, in person. The ambulance should have all the equipment in its designated location so that the Learner(s) can learn what things are, and where they are. You will also need a copy of your service's ambulance checklist.

If your service does not use a checklist for ambulance checks, you can use Maine EMS's Ambulance Inspection Checklist for <u>Transporting</u> or <u>Non-Transporting</u> Agencies.

Description

Have your Learner(s) go through your service's ambulance checklist and find each piece of equipment. Consider breaking the checklist up into smaller sections to make it easier to remember. This activity can be completed multiple times, until you are confident that your Learner could retrieve any of the supplies on the checklist.

Completion Requirements

Mentors should indicate how many hours each Learner spent on this activity in the EMS ConnectME Hands-On Activity Hours Tracking Form.

Learners should be able to successfully complete the checklist in order to move on to Ambulance/Equipment Competency 103.

Tip: If you have more than one Learner, they can work on the checklist together. Each one can become an "expert" on part of the rig, and then teach the other(s). They may be able to help each other succeed while they are learning.
