Key

- Common Course Acronym:** This is an acronym by which the course is frequently referred.
- Course Name:** This is the actual name of the course. This is the name by which users should enter the course into their eLicensing CEH records.
- Type of Course:** As a “quick find” aid, courses are grouped together in the table by common topics
- Max Hours for Category:** Some courses contain known maximums of specific content. This lists the maximum number of hours that could be used for that category.
- CEH Content Categories:** These are the categories to which CEH hours can be applied based upon the course content.
- Check Box:** A check in the category box indicates that hours from the course may be used here. You may distribute hours as best meets your CEH needs (unless there is a MAX hours listed for the category listed). You can use up to the MAX course hours available for the course.
- Max Course Hours:** This is the maximum number of hours the course is worth. The total hours used in each category must not exceed the MAX course hours. You should distribute all course hours listed, among the applicable categories shown in the table for the course, even if it exceeds the hours you need for that category. *NOTE: If you have more hours in a category than you need, the excess hours will be shifted to LCCR/ICCR content in your CEH record. LCCR/ICCR content is flexible content*

Instructions

- a. Find your Standardized CEH Curriculum course in the table.
- b. From the course name, read the table row left to right, noting the CEH content category boxes with check marks in them. **These are the categories for which the course has applicable content.**
- c. Continue along the table row to the right and note the course max hours. **This is the total amount of CEH hours the course is worth.**
- d. You may distribute the course CEH hours among the categories for which the course has content (check mark in the box) as you need, until there are no more hours to distribute. NOTE: *Some boxes contain verbiage listing the max content hours which may be applied to the respective category.*
- e. You may then enter the CEH hours as you've distributed them into your CEH record in eLicensing.
