MEMS will be monitoring LD 196 “An Act Regarding the Implementation of the Quality Assurance Program for Public Safety Answering Points”; LD 235 “ An Act to Improve Insurance Coverage for Volunteer Responders”; LD 275 “Resolve, to Require the Emergency Services Communication Bureau to Expand the Existing quality Assurance System”; and is the lead agency for LD 298 “An Act Regarding the Membership of the Emergency Medical Services Board.” The EMS Memorial Bike Ride will officially be starting in Augusta this year. Jay, Matt Sholl, and Don Sheets plan to participate, and welcome any others that are interested. Special Circumstances Protocol	Delta Ambulance requested a special circumstances protocol for the use of a ventilator during an emergency situation as the patient is a brittle CPPD patient that will not tolerate supplemental oxygen other than a vent. Life Flight of Maine Off Protocol Policy	Dr. Sholl and Norm Dinerman have vetted this policy as presented to the MDPB in June 2012. As this is a first time for a policy that would allow providers to perform outside of the scope of practice, Matt suggested forming a committee to further review this policy. This committee would include personnel from LFOM, Don, Peter, Jon, Jay and Matt.	
Protocol Review Discussion	<p>Green: Busko</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Trauma triage guideline – TAC is with this guideline. 2. Add a Termination of Resuscitation of Trauma Codes. Matt and Jonathan to review the wording. <p>PINK: Chagrasulis</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Add a Pain Management protocol: change Fentanyl dose to 1 micrograms/kg/IV/IM/IN every 5 minutes. May be repeated at .5 mics for a total of 5 micrograms/kg/IV/IM/IN. 2. Leave the nitronox wording the same as the adult pain management protocol. 3. Add an Apparent Life-Threatening Event (ALTE) protocol. Express the need to transport child even if they now appear normal and to contact Medical Control if the parents refuse. 	
Drug Shortages	Nitro Paste, D-50, Sodium-Bicarb and Magnesium shortages. Some of the prefilled syringes have been changed to vials that need to be drawn up. Matt encouraged the regions to continue to keep good communications with the hospital pharmacies.
