Growing Clean Energy Jobs and Innovation Across Maine

Growing Maine's Clean Energy Workforce

Maine has nearly **15,600 clean energy jobs** and counting. Through the Clean Energy Partnership, the Maine Department of Energy Resources (DOER) provided nearly **1,400 Maine people** with workforce training and career support through grant funded programs in 2025. DOER's job board, the *Maine Clean Energy Jobs Network*, reached over **33,000 people** and served nearly **160 job seekers** in the past year.

Boosting Cleantech Innovation

In 2025, innovation programs supported with grant funding from the Clean Energy Partnership served **nearly 2,000 individuals** and at least **28 small and startup businesses** in Maine's growing cleantech sector.

Supporting Economic Revitalization

The Maine Community Energy Redevelopment Program provided technical assistance to **7 communities** across the state to support locally determined revitalization projects at current and former industrial sites to create good-paying jobs, drive local economic development, and advance state energy goals.
