2. Request for Penalty Waiver – Hon. Laura Supica

Rep. Laura Supica, a 2024 candidate for the Maine House of Representatives, was required to file a 24-Hour Report on October 26, 2024. Her treasurer filed the report on January 22, 2025. Rep. Supica requests a waiver of the preliminary penalty of \$1,938.64. *Staff recommendation: the Commission staff recommends reducing the penalty to \$300.*

3. Request for Penalty Waiver – Hon. Holly Rae Eaton

Rep. Holly Rae Eaton, a candidate for the Maine House of Representatives, was required to file the 42-Day Post-General Report on December 17, 2024. Her treasurer filed the report on December 23. Rep. Eaton requests a waiver of the preliminary penalty of \$1,117.21. *Staff recommendation: the Commission staff recommends reducing the penalty to \$300.*

4. Proposed Stakeholder Group to Simplify Pre-Election Deadlines
