- 2. Penalty for Failure to File Campaign Finance Report 2020 Candidate John DeVeau John DeVeau was a 2020 legislative candidate. Because his campaign finance reports have indicated he continues to have a campaign surplus over \$100, he has been required to file semiannual reports each January 15th and July 15th. In spite of multiple communications from Commission staff, Mr. DeVeau did not file a report due January 15, 2025. Staff recommendation: staff recommends assessing a penalty of \$500.
