Commissioners:

I write to update my July 19, 2019 letter, regarding the Mills Inaugural Committee fundraising, to incorporate activity through today. Less than six weeks have passed since the Legislature adjourned *sine die*. In that time, the Committee received \$10,500 and secured additional pledges of \$81,000 (**updated number**). The Committee has paid \$100,000 on the Augusta Civic Center invoice and \$94,901.70 remains. As of July 26, 2019, the Committee's cash balance is \$25,062.46. The Committee continues fundraising to complete payment of its expenses.

We look forward to resolving this issue.
