For Committees registered with the Ethics Commission, the reports may be filed electronically through the Commission's website. Any single expenditure of \$1,000 or more made during the reporting period. Orders placed with or obligations made to vendors for goods or services are considered expenditures at the time the orders or obligations are made. Overhead costs, such as rent, taxes, utilities and some salary payments are not required to be reported.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All regular campaign finance reports are due by 11:59 p.m. on the due date. The Commission's office will close at its regularly scheduled time. Committee Treasurers are responsible for filing the campaign finance reports prior to the Commission's office closing or for making other arrangements with the Commission's office. Failure to seek out timely assistance from staff regarding the filing of reports will not be considered a mitigating circumstance if a report is filed late.
