2023 FILING SCHEDULE

For All PACs, BQCS & State Party Committees participating in the November 2023 Election

Initial Campaign Finance Reports

All new committees must file an Initial Report within 7 days of registration or within 14 days of when they exceeded \$2,500 (for PACs) or \$5,000 (for BQCs) in financial activity. For PACs, the Initial Report covers all activity from the beginning of the year through the date of registration. For BQCs, the Initial Report covers all activity from the beginning of the campaign through the date of registration.

24-Hour Report of Contributions and Expenditures

(Supplemental Reports)

If a PAC or BQC receives more than \$5,000 from a single source or makes a single expenditure of \$1,000 or more during the below time periods then the committee must file a supplemental report within 24-Hours of that transactions, including Saturdays, Sundays, and/or Holidays. For expenditures, orders placed with or obligations made to vendors are considered expenditures at the time the orders or obligations are made. Overhead expenditures, such as rent, taxes, utilities, and some salary payments are exempt from this requirement.

Independent Expenditure Reports

(Supplemental Reports)

A paid communication that depicts clearly identified candidate(s) must be report via an independent expenditure report if the expenditure exceeds \$250 per candidate and the communication was made and disseminated independent of the candidate or the candidate's committee.

Important Information

All regular campaign finance reports are due by 11:59 p.m. on the due date. The Commission's office will close at its regularly scheduled time. Failure to seek out timely assistance from staff regarding the filing of reports will not be considered a mitigating circumstance if a report is filed late.
