



## Request for Waiver Requiring a Separate Campaign Account

### For all PACs and BQCs

Title 21-A M.R.S. § 1054(2) requires that all PACs and BQCs have a separate campaign account for the receipt of all contributions and payment of all expenditures for the purpose of initiating or influencing a campaign. If a business or corporate entity established the committee; these funds must be separate from the general treasury funds of that entity. If the PAC or BQC is established by individual(s), then these funds must be separate from the personal funds of any member. A PAC or BQC may use this form to request a waiver of this requirement.
