Beginning Wednesday, March 18, 2020, the staff of the Maine Ethics Commission will not be available for in-person meetings and visitors will not be able to enter the office. As we have previously notified MCEA candidates, requests for certifications should be mailed to the Commission. The memo describing the new procedure for submitting your request for certification, along with mailing instructions, is available on the Commission's website: <u>www.maine.gov/ethics</u>.

If you do come to the Commission's office, you may leave your MCEA certification submission in the drop box outside the office door. There are drop-off instructions near the drop box as well as envelopes to insert your certification submission. If you use your own envelope, please be sure to seal the envelope and write your name and district number on the outside of the envelope. You may also use the drop box for candidate registrations, vendor and direct deposit forms, and any other documents you need to give to the staff. The staff will periodically check the drop box throughout the day but, again, the staff will not meet with candidates individually. The drop box will not be available after 5:00 p.m. or on weekends.

Please be aware that the deadline for requesting MCEA certification and submitting certification materials is <u>April 21, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.</u> The deadline has not been extended and the staff does not anticipate that it will be.

The response to the coronavirus (COVID-19) is rapidly evolving. If there are any other changes to our procedures, we will notify you as soon as possible. We encourage you to check the citizen alert system link on <u>www.maine.gov</u> for updates on office closures before coming to the Commission's office.
