 - Discussed benefits of reduction, need for and benefit of tracking at restaurants; financial savings from tracking to reduce food waste.
 - Discussed potential ideas to divert more, including:
 - Statewide train the trainer program, partnering with COGs and regional planning organizations, more backyard bins, highlighting National Food Waste Prevention week, partnering with schools, supporting municipalities and local composters with more hub-and-spoke collection, providing tax credits for food donation with tiers providing more incentive for donation but some credit for diversion (composting, AD).
