Building an Age-Inclusive Workforce

With the support of Maine DOL, the Cabinet has finalized a research project in partnership with the Cutler Institute at the University of Southern Maine, to better understand the motivations and barriers older workers face in remaining in or reentering the workforce and opportunities for action.

This work will be completed in 2025 and provides an opportunity for Maine to continue to lead the way and advance solutions that help with workforce and building stronger economies and communities for all
