- Partnership: University of New England Center for Excellence in Public Health and UMaine - Center on Aging ~ Second 5-year grant funded as of July 1, 2024
- Education and training for a more capable Health Care workforce, focusing on
  - all health care professions
  - especially direct care workers (DCW) in long term care
  - interprofessional teamwork
- Empowering older adults to take part in their health care
  - The 4Ms Framework: What Matters, Medication, Mentation, Mobility


