

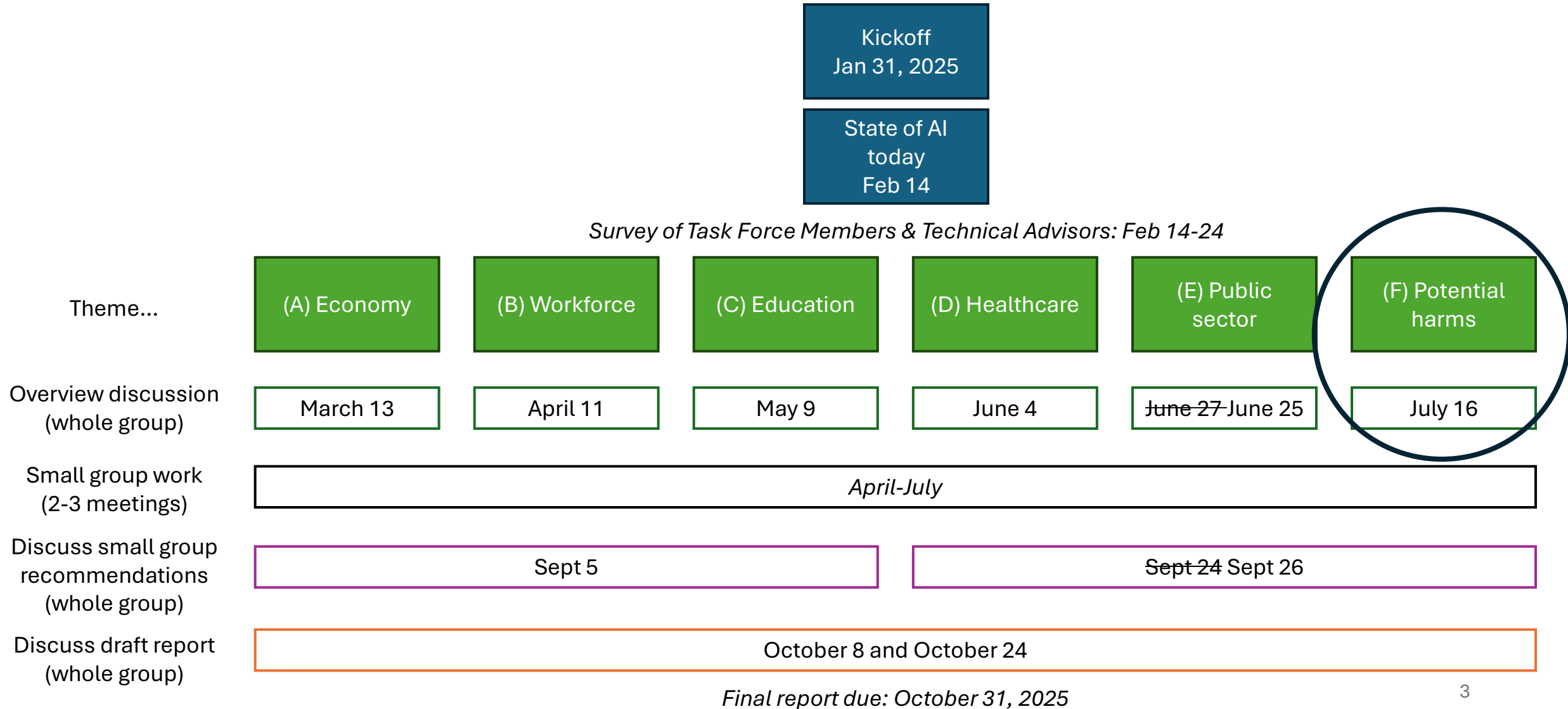

<a href="#">LD 1944</a> : clarifies threats to disseminate AI images within framework of revenge porn laws.	JUD	Enacted, signed law
Artist copyrights		
<a href="#">LD 109</a> : directs Maine Arts Commission to study protection of artists from AI copyright infringement.	EDU	Enacted, held by Governor
Health insurance		
<a href="#">LD 1301</a> : seeks to regulate the use of AI in health insurance claims.	HCIFS	Carried over
Campaign advertising		
<a href="#">LD 1690</a> : sought to require disclosure of AI-manipulated media used in political communications.	VLA	Killed in committee*
Social media in schools		
<a href="#">LD 643</a> : sought to direct DOE to study AI and student use of social media in schools.	EDU	Killed in committee
Landlord anti-competitive practices		
<a href="#">LD 1552</a> : sought to prohibit landlords from using AI to collude in setting rents,	JUD	Killed in committee
State procurement		
<a href="#">LD 872</a> : sought to require OIT to maintain a list of approved AI software for state procurement and ensure public transparency.	SLG	Killed in committee

7. Cybersecurity Threats

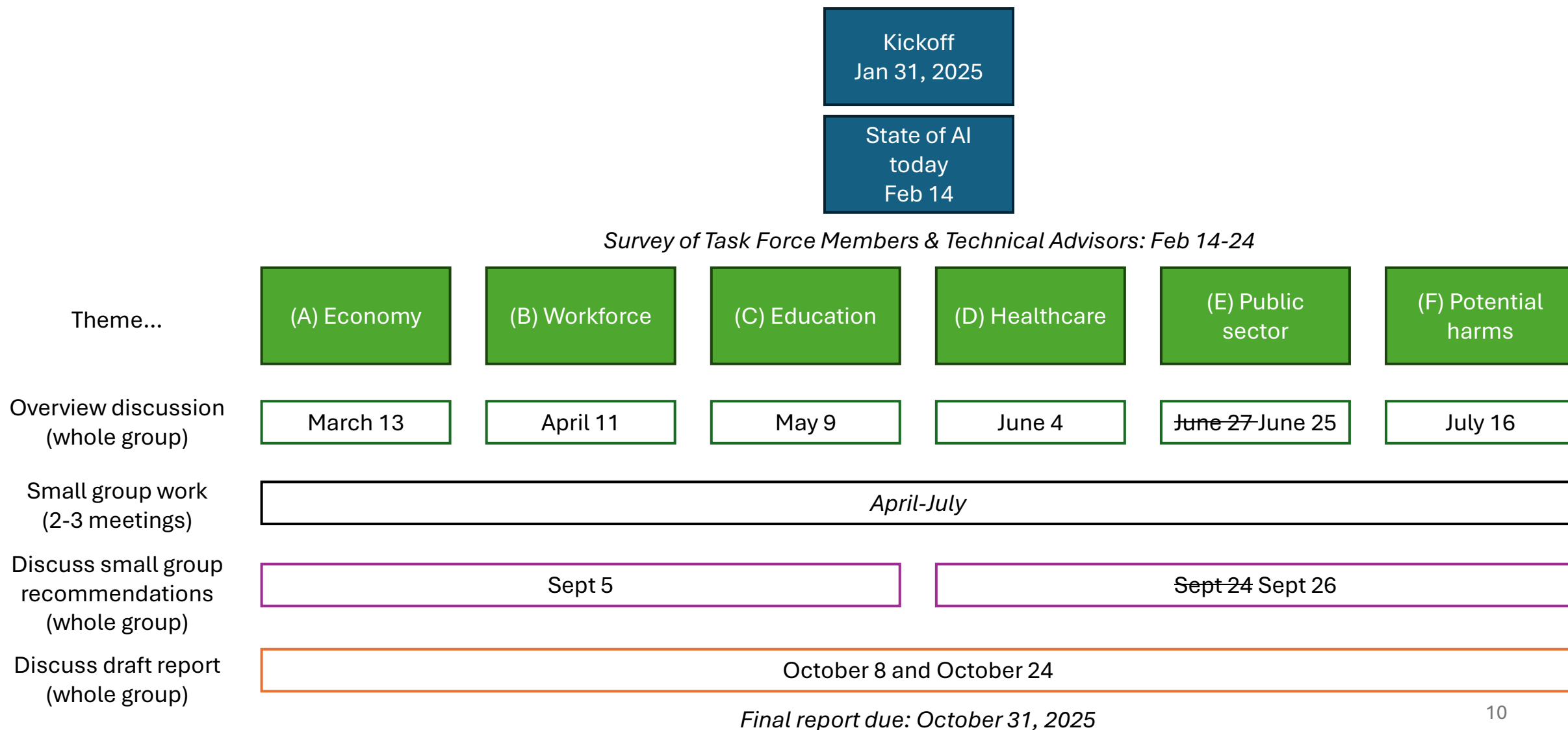

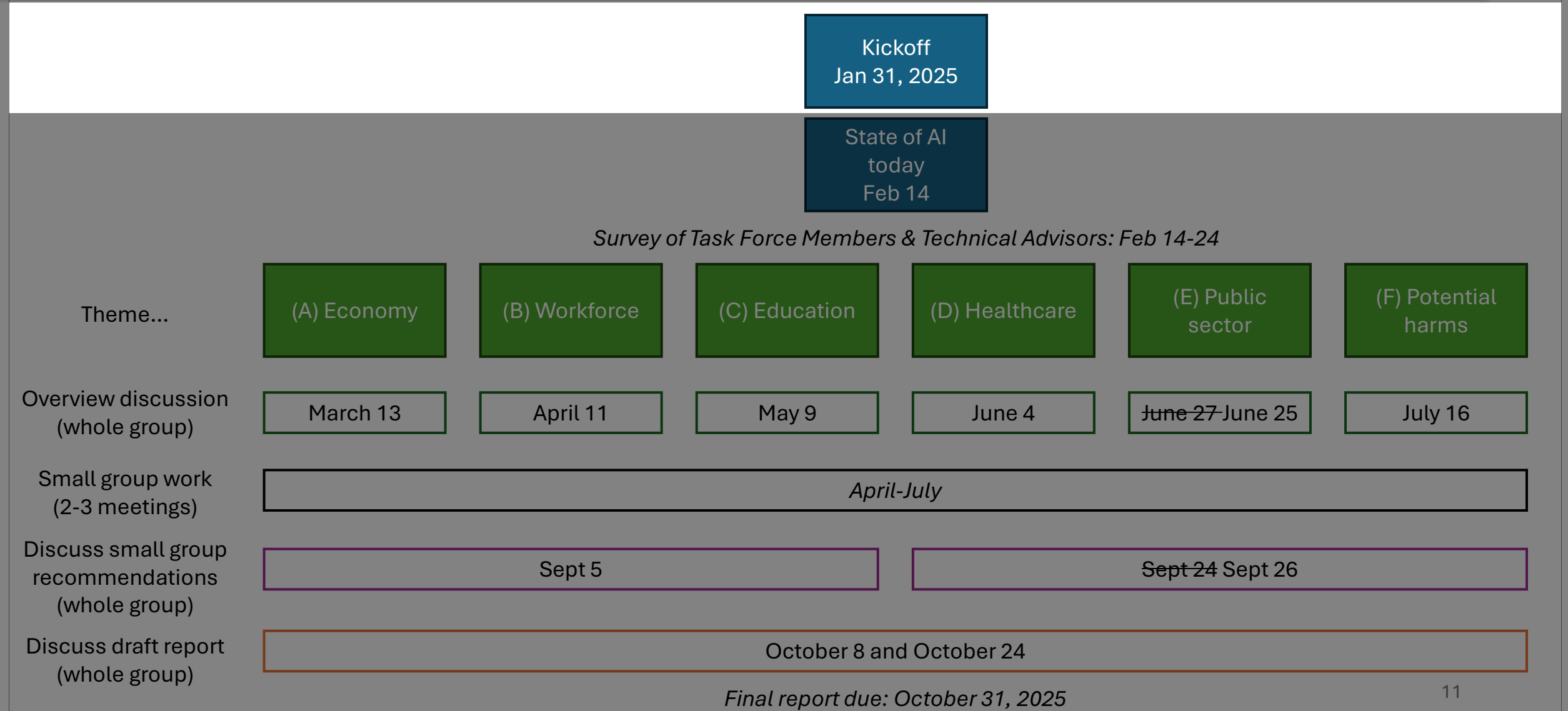

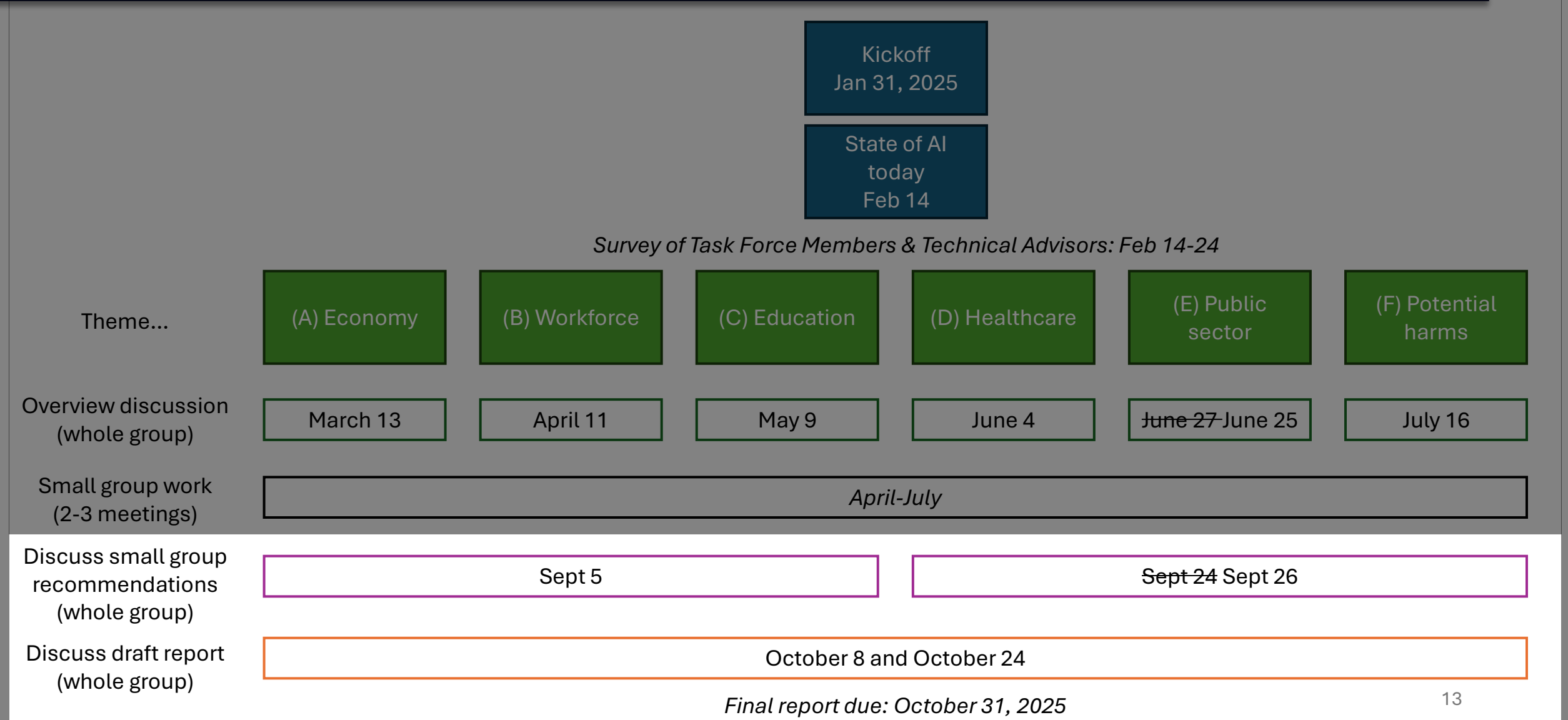
