- promoting service as a strategy





Using National Service to Address Critical Needs in Maine

Maine Service Fellows

- Maine's State Service Program modeled after national service programs
- Five Fellows annually serving 10-month terms
- Supports capacity building in rural communities



AmeriCorps

- Volunteer Maine supports \$2M in programming in 2025 to support 8 programs that engaged 108 AmeriCorps members Statewide
- Focus on rural and underserved communities
- Volunteer Maine also coordinates with AmeriCorps Seniors, VISTA, NCCC



Maine Climate Corps Network

- A community of practice that connects climate-focused volunteer and service programs to coordinate activities, learn, and for peer support.
- Often offers mini-grants for members to do professional development for themselves or their service members!
