 - Financial Committee Chair LD877 "bucket" established
 - Policy & Marketing Committee Vinton Valentine (not here) There are no policies but we will
 want to draft a policy regarding the Executive Director, the person will be an OIT employee and
 will be subject to the policies of state employees. (Bill Hanson just dialed in and joined the
 meeting) Board needs to understand that this position is not administrative assistance, but
 rather a salesman and evangelist: someone who can manage projects and manage money
 and go out and get the support of the GEO spatial community in Maine. End result is expected
 to increase Ortho and LiDAR program. The Executive Director will be able to lobby, as long as
 they are directed by the Board. This opens up the possibility of a legislative agenda for the
 Board. Hiring committee will come up with a policy that relates what we want the Executive
 Director to do.
 - Technical Committee Christopher Kroot GeoPortal Update and Discussion & Future of the Portal - Received an invite to meet with the University, Chistopher responded, but hasn't heard back. So the holding pattern continues. There is talk about adding metadata to GeoPlatform.gov Hoping for an ArcGIS on line solution eventually. <u>GeoPlatform.gov</u> is being investigated as an out-of-the-box solution. Still waiting for ESRI to respond about providing us with a temporary backup to the Metadata catalog.
