## Suggested Management

Since there is an abundance of smallmouth bass and white perch already present in Pennesseewassee Lake, management should be primarily concerned with these two species. However; reports indicate that some fishing is enjoyed for brown trout and brook trout. These two species should also be considered in the management of the lake.

Liberalized fishing for bass and perch might produce more trout fishing by controlling the populations of warm-water species.
