Ordering Information 2019 MAINE DUCK STAMPS

Maine's 2019 duck stamp will be available by September 1st for purchase by stamp collectors. In 2003, Maine implemented electronic licenses whereby waterfowl hunting is an authority printed on the electronic license or a check-off box on a manual license. Agents no longer have collector stamps to sell.

Mint condition stamps may be purchases from the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, either in person or by mail (using the order form below). Stamps signed by the artist are also available from the Department. The 2019 stamp was designed by Richard A. Alley Jr., of Islesford, Maine, whose painting of a Canada Goose, was selected from the contest entries submitted by Maine resident artists.

The Department will sell the 2019 Maine duck stamp until June 30, 2020, after which any unsold stamps will be destroyed. Previous issues (1984-2018) were sold under the same procedure and are available only on the secondary market, from stamp collectors and dealers.
