Please send the completed application, copies of both sides of current first aid card, and the \$100.00 fee to Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, 284 State Street, Augusta, ME 04333.

If, due to a disability, you need any accommodation during the exam process, you must notify IFW 10 business days prior to the exam date.

NOTE: Failure to appear for a scheduled exam without a 24-hour notice will result in a one year waiting period.
