Submit completed application, letter from Warden Service and license fee to address on front. Current first aid is not required to renew a guide license. **Effective 7-1-98 a renewal applicant whose guiding authority has been expired for 3 years must apply as a new guide and be reexamined.**

NEW APPLICANTS - (Testing process for new applicants normally takes from 6 months to a year.) All new applicants must be currently certified by the American Red Cross in standard first-aid or completion of any standard first-aid course that meets the criteria established by rule of the commissioner. **Please note that we do NOT accept online courses.** Complete entire form, front and back. Each new guide applicant must pay a \$100.00 fee in each classification to be examined to become a guide. In the event the applicant fails the test, one re-examination is allowed before another application fee is assessed. The \$100.00 fee is non-refundable and will not be credited toward the license fee. Please send the completed application, copies of both sides of current First Aid card, a copy of your successful background check letter and the \$100.00 fee to Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, 284 State Street, Augusta, ME 04333. **If, due to a disability, you need any accommodation in the exam process, you need to notify us 10 business days prior to the exam date.**

Note: Failure to appear for exam without a 24 hour prior notice will result in a one year waiting period.
