## 2023-24 MAINE HUNTING QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

#### LICENSES

To hunt in Maine, you need to have one of the 30+ hunting licenses available. These vary by category of game, equipment used, resident status, age, and other factors. Go to mefishwildlife.com to see which license type is right for you, and to read what the license allows, when it allows it, and what permits are included or need to be purchased separately.

#### PERMITS

To hunt for certain game or with certain equipment, you need to buy a permit. For example, archery licenses allow yearround bow and arrow hunting for all legal game, except for deer during the muzzleloading season. During that time, you also need a muzzleloading permit. And during the expanded archery season, you need to purchase extra deer permits.

Some permits are included in certain licenses. For example, the junior hunting license includes a bear permit, but nonresident licenses don't. These license-holders must buy regular or November (late-season) bear permits to hunt for bear during the firearm season on deer.

#### **STAMPS**

Waterfowl hunters age 16 and up must purchase state waterfowl permits and federal duck stamps. 16-year-olds still hunting on a junior license may hunt on a youth day, but need a Federal duck stamp.

Migratory waterfowl permits are not required to hunt Crow, Woodcock, Common Snipe, Sora & Virginia Rails, or Gallinules. A pheasant permit is required to hunt pheasant in York and Cumberland counties.

### SUNDAY HUNTING IS ILLEGAL IN MAINE

**LEGAL HUNTING HOURS:**  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour before sunrise to  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour

after sunset. Exceptions: Migratory game birds, raccoons, and coyote.

#### HUNTER ORANGE CLOTHING

Hunter orange is defined as a daylight fluorescent orange color with a dominant wave length between 595 and 605 nanometers, excitation purity of at least 85% and luminance factor of at least 40%. A decal on an article of clothing that is otherwise solid hunter orange is permissible. Articles of hunter orange clothing must be in good and serviceable condition and visible from all sides.

In the Maine woods, rarely will anyone be there to notice your ethical behavior, but the landowner and the hunters that follow will greatly appreciate it. Ethical behavior is vital to Maine's sporting future, and it encourages landowners to keep their property open for all to enjoy. So remember: always respect the rights of landowners, and please *ask first*.

A verification form must be completed and can be located on our website.

\*\*\*\*Hunters that are issued a moose permit for the Adaptive Unit/WMD 4A moose hunt who do not harvest a moose during the first week listed on their permit may hunt in their respective zone 11/6/2023-11/11/2023.
