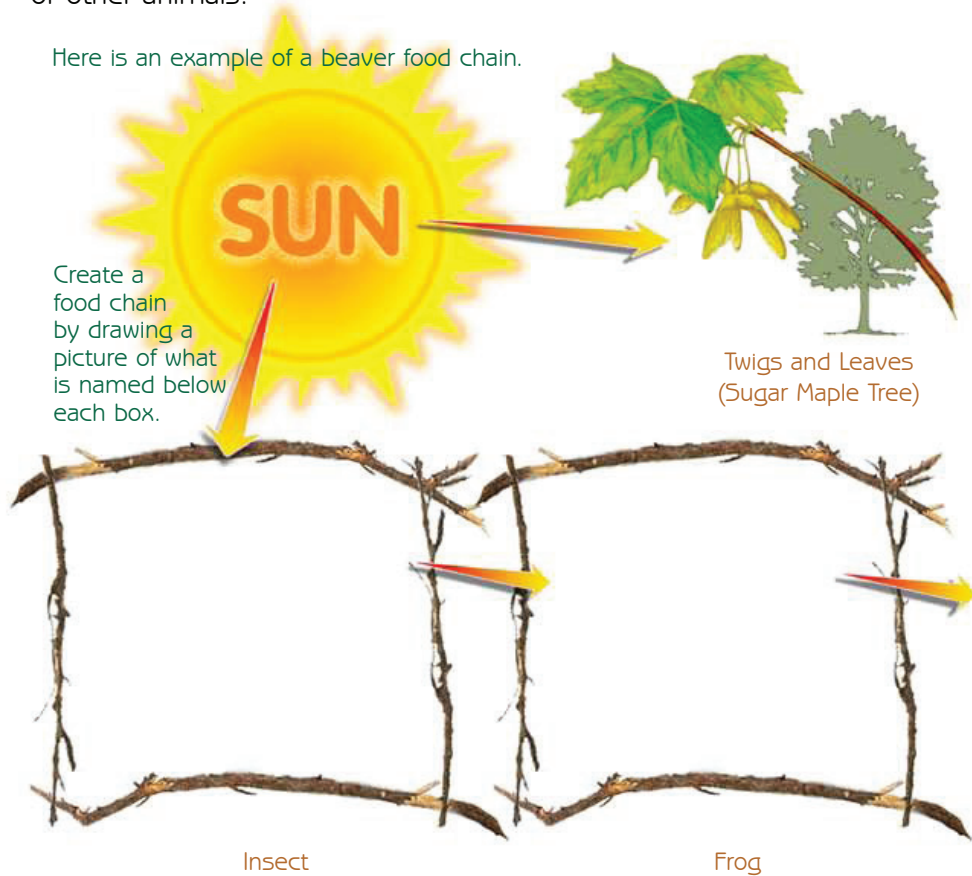




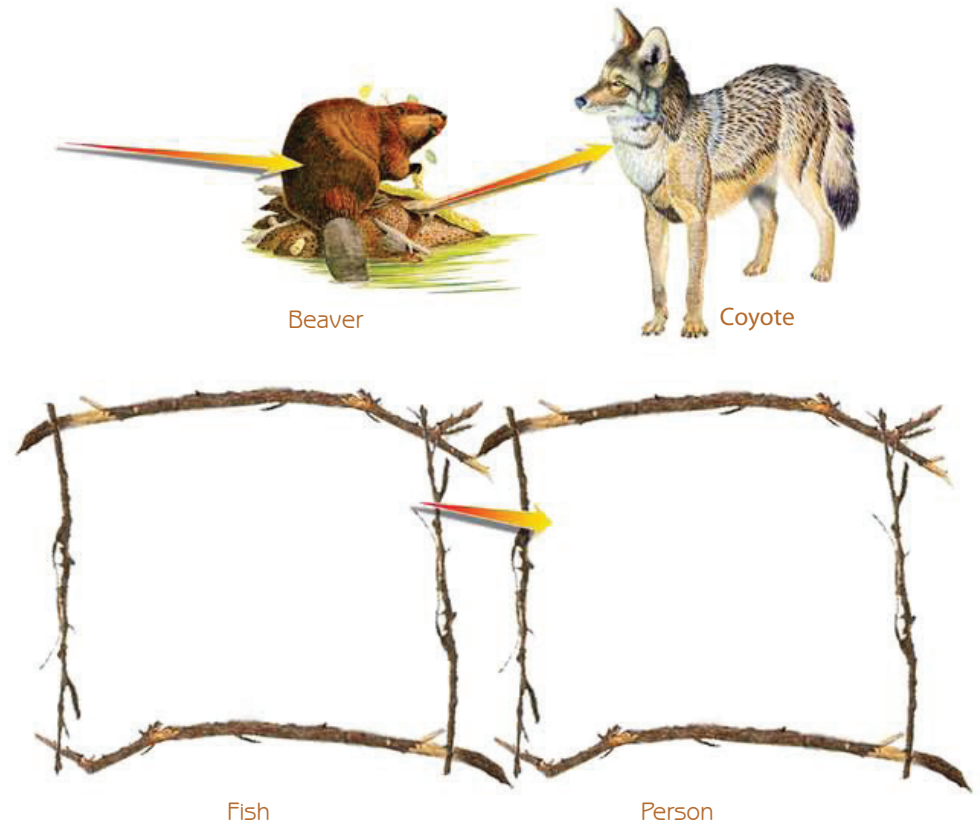
Beavers in the Food Chain

All living things in a habitat are connected. Food chains show these connections. All food chains start with the sun. Green plants use the sun's energy to make sugars. Animals get energy by eating plants or other animals.

Here is an example of a beaver food chain.



What's your favorite food? Beavers like to eat the bark and twigs of poplar, aspen, birch, willow and maple trees. They also eat water plants such as water lily and cattail. Predators of beaver are coyotes, foxes, bobcats, otters and great-horned owls.
