Good afternoon Senator Dill, Representative Nadeau and members of the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Committee. I am Jim Connolly, Resource Management Director for the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, representing the Department in support of **L.D. 490**.

This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to change a trapping season opening date if weather conditions make that change necessary.

The Department supports the intent of the bill to provide more flexibility in setting the trapping season length if weather conditions would make it difficult to meet the harvest management goals. However, the Department is not as supportive of the language as written because it only allows flexibility in the opening date of the trapper season and doesn't allow an extension of the season from the time is would normally close. We look forward to working with the bill sponsor and this Committee to clarify the intent.
