The public use of private land is a critical issue affecting all who recreate in Maine. As the new Commissioner, I would like time to consider all options, by reviewing the Maine Land Conservation Task Force recommendations, consult with the Landowner and Sportsmen Advisory Board, and speak with Governor Mills regarding the future for the Departments Landowner Relations Program.
