As a Big Game Registration Station, you serve as a representative of the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, as well as an Agent of the State of Maine. The registration information that you collect provides an important piece in MDIFW's efforts at sound wildlife management. MDIFW personnel process and analyze data to determine estimated post-harvest population levels, distributions, and management needs to make future harvest recommendations for consideration by the Commissioner, Advisory Council, and the Maine Legislature.

We recognize that many stations register multiple species and that hunting seasons may occur during busy times for your business. We also understand that, as a business owner, you have other challenges to face. However, accurate and timely registration data are essential to MDIFW's purposes.

MDIFW appreciates the efforts of those businesses that serve as Big Game Registration Stations; they provide a very important service. But, it is critical that clear and accurate data is collected and provided to MDIFW in a timely manner. Only those stations who comply with these instructions will be eligible for reappointment as Big Game Registration Stations. We hope that we can rely on you for this important responsibility.

Registering an Animal

- 1) To begin a registration transaction, enter the Station's Registration Agent First and Last Name on the Main Menu page. This will identify which clerk within the registration station submitted the animal.
- 2) Select Big Game if your station has the ability to register fur.
- 3) Select the Animal to be Tagged from the dropdown menu.
- 4) Once you have selected an animal, the Animal Being Registered will appear. Select the sex/age.
- 5) Enter the Date of Kill (format is MM DD YYYY) or choose from the calendar.
Note: a future date will not be accepted.
- 6) Enter the Time of Kill (format for this field is HH MM). There is a separate dropdown to select AM/PM.
- 7) Select the Season in which you are registering the animal from the dropdown menu.
Note: only seasons within the date of kill will be shown. If the hunter is claiming a different season, check if the date of kill is correct.
- 8) Choose YES if you have the MOSES ID of the hunter. Enter that number in the box below and the hunter's Last Name and Date of Birth (all components need to match). If you do not have the MOSES ID or if the name/MOSES ID/DOB do not match, select NO and attempt to lookup the hunter by Full Name and Date of Birth (more on page 6 of the guide).
- 9) After entering all of the information, click Continue.

If you entered a **MOSES ID, last name, and DOB** but the hunter is not found, first click the [Search Again](#) link. Confirm that everything was entered correctly. If still no results are found, attempt to lookup the hunter by **Full Name and Date of Birth**.

If you entered the Name and Date of Birth and the hunter is still not found, first click the **1)** [Search Again](#) link. Confirm that the Name and Date of Birth were entered correctly and try again.

If still no results are found, you may need to ask the hunter if they go by a shortened name or nickname that their license may be listed under (e.g. "Dan, Danny, Daniel"). Do not punctuate any part of the name (e.g. hyphenated last name, apostrophes).

Finally, if there is still no MOSES profile found, you can continue with the registration transaction by clicking the link **2)** [Create new hunter in MOSES](#)

Note: Doing this will create a new profile with no license information attached to it. You will be required to enter in the complete profile (eye color, weight, address, etc.) in addition to the license and permit information.





Multiple Hunters Found

When searching without a MOSES but by **Name** and **Date of Birth**, the system may find multiple MOSES profiles for the hunter. You will be asked to select one to continue. Choose the option that has the most up-to-date information.

If you select Continue to view the hunter's full profile. If it appears that the information is incorrect (e.g. no license listed), click [Wrong Hunter?](#) to go back and select a different profile that may have the correct license and permit information associated with it.



Confirmation

After successfully completing the registration transaction, a confirmation page will be displayed containing all the information that was entered during the transaction.

The hunter will receive a copy of this information to their email address if it is part of their MOSES record or was entered during the transaction.

After submitting the registration, you will be brought back to the beginning to register a new animal. If the webpage is unused for an hour, the system will timeout and make you log in again before registering an animal.

Big Game Seals

To provide an accurate record of the number of big game animals harvested and to aid MDIFW in its management efforts for these important species, Maine State law requires that every big game animal harvested be registered.

All big game (wild turkey, bear, deer, moose) use the same year-specific MAINE BIG GAME plastic seals (e.g. green for 2023). At the end of the last big game season, please return any unused seals to MDIFW. New seals will be issued for the following year.

When your station drops below 15% of your allotted seals, a notification will automatically be sent to MDIFW to mail more seals to your station and add them to your online station profile. You can also contact tech support at GameFurRegistration.MDIFW@maine.gov

Note: Only seals allocated to your online station profile can be used to register big game.

Animal-Specific Registration Instructions


TURKEY

Collect and retain registration fee of \$2.

The plastic Maine Big Game seal must be attached by the registration station attendant (NOT THE HUNTER) to the wing or leg.

Use a knife to make a slit in the turkey's wing just behind the tendon (see diagram).

Put the flexible seal ribbon through the slit, pass it around the tendon and insert the end of ribbon into the round head, pushing it into the head as far as possible. Pull back on the ribbon to ensure the seal is locked. If you put the seal around the leg instead of the wing, wrap it **twice** so it cannot be pulled over the foot.



Check **every turkey** for leg bands, transmitter backpack, or radio-collar.

- marked animals are legal game; hunters/trappers legally harvesting these animals do not face penalties.
- **record** band color and band/transmitter number under Animal and Weapon Information page.
- **remove** radio collars or transmitter backpacks.
- email GameFurRegistration.MDIFW@maine.gov to report information of marked turkeys.


BEAR

Collect registration fee of \$5. The station retains \$2 and must return the remaining \$3 to MDIFW.

The plastic Maine Big Game seal must be attached by the registration station attendant (NOT THE HUNTER OR TRAPPER).

Use a knife to make a slit in the bear's hind leg just in front of the tendon (see diagram).

Put the flexible seal ribbon through the slit, pass it around the tendon and insert the end of the ribbon into the round head, pushing it into the head as far as possible. Pull back on ribbon to ensure the seal is locked.



Hunters are **legally required to submit a tooth** from the bear they harvest. It is the hunter's responsibility to extract the tooth and label the envelope. It is your responsibility to:

- post the instruction sheet provided by MDIFW in a place for bear hunters to consult.
- provide an MDIFW tooth collection envelope to each successful bear hunter.
- ask the hunter to return the envelope to you with the tooth enclosed.
- when the tooth collection envelope is returned to you, check that the envelope is **legibly** labeled with **hunter's name, sex of bear, date of kill, town of kill, and seal number.**
- place tooth envelope in manila postage-paid business reply envelope provided by MDIFW.
- at the end of the bear season, mail the postage-paid envelope in the mail with teeth and unused envelopes enclosed.

Check **every bear** for ear tags, a tattoo (located on the inside of the upper or lower lip), or radio-collar.

- marked bears are legal game; hunters/trappers legally harvesting these animals do not face penalties.
- **record** ear tag/collar color and number under Animal and Weapon Information page.
- **remove radio-collars** using a wrench (do not cut the collar off) and record name, address, and phone number of hunters or trappers registering marked bears on the ear tag envelope.
- email GameFurRegistration.MDIFW@maine.gov to report information of marked bears.

MOOSE

Collect registration fee of \$5. The station retains \$2 and must return the remaining \$3 to MDIFW.

A moose may be dismembered for ease of transportation, and the lower legs, head, and hide may be removed. If the head is not brought to the station, a canine tooth or lower jaw must then be presented at time of registration.

The plastic Maine Big Game seal must be attached by the registration station attendant (NOT THE HUNTER). Record the seal number on the back of the hunter's moose permit. Use a knife to make a slit in the moose's hind leg just in front of the tendon (see diagram). Put the flexible seal ribbon through the slit, pass it around the tendon and insert the end of the ribbon into round head, pushing it into the head as far as possible. Pull back on the ribbon to ensure the seal is locked.



MDIFW biologists have fitted moose in WMDs 8, 2, and 4 with radio-collars and/or ear tags, which provide important information on Maine moose status and movements.

- marked moose are legal game; hunters legally harvesting these animals do not face penalties.
- **record** ear tag/collar color and number under Animal and Weapon Information page.
- **remove radio-collars** using a wrench (do not cut the collar off).
- email GameFurRegistration.MDIFW@maine.gov to report information of marked moose.

DEER

Collect registration fee of \$5. The station retains \$2 and must return the remaining \$3 to MDIFW.

The plastic Maine Big Game seal must be attached by the registration station attendant (NOT THE HUNTER). Use a knife to make a slit in the deer's hind leg just in front of the tendon (see diagram). Put the flexible seal ribbon through the slit, pass it around the tendon and insert the end of the ribbon into the round head, pushing it into the head as far as possible. Pull back on the ribbon to ensure the seal is locked.



MDIFW biologists have fitted deer with ear tags and radio-collars for a winter survival study.

- marked deer are legal game; hunters legally harvesting these animals do not face penalties.
- **record ear tags** under the Research Animal section of the website.
- **remove radio-collars** using a wrench (do not cut the collar off).
- email GameFurRegistration.MDIFW@maine.gov to report information of marked deer.

Technical Support

If it is impossible to enter the harvest information online (e.g. **loss of internet connectivity**), contact call-in registration at **1-888-254-4340** to enter the harvest information via phone 24 hours a day and 7 days a week. **Do not** let the hunter leave without registering the animal and **do not** use a paper registration book.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: My internet connection is down—how do I register an animal?

A: Contact the call center at **1-888-254-4340**. You and the hunter will register the animal over the phone.

Q: Why can I not enter a county/WMD?

A: They are automatically selected based on town. Be sure that you are selecting the town from the dropdown list.

Q: Why is the town I want to select is not available on the dropdown list?

A: Only official towns are recognized. Consult a gazetteer for the correct name. For township and range, the format is T# R# with a space between township and range. Towns like St Agatha should be entered as “saint”.

Q: When I enter a seal number, why do I keep getting an error?

A: Skip that seal and use a different one to finish registering the harvest. Contact GameFurRegistration.MDIFW@maine.gov with the seal number(s) and the problem. Each seal can only be used once—a previous registration may have accidentally entered your current seal number, which cannot be used again. Once the problem is fixed, you will be contacted and can use that seal for the next registration.

Q: I submitted a harvest record but made a mistake—how can I correct the information?

A: Send an email to GameFurRegistration.MDIFW@maine.gov with the seal number of the harvest record and explain what information needs to be corrected.

Q: Why is the season I want to select not available?

A: Double-check the date of kill above. The list of seasons is based on the date the animal was killed.

Q: Why am I getting an error on the date of kill?

A: Assuming you entered the format correctly (MMDDYYYY), you cannot enter a date in the future.

Q: The hunter has a permit—why is the choice not available on the permit dropdown list?

A: Assuming you have the correct hunter profile (double-check name and address) the permit is not yet in the MOSES system. On the dropdown list, select **Permit not listed**. You will then manually enter the permit type and number in the boxes that appear below.

Q: A landowner came in without a license. How do I register the animal?

A: On the hunter information page, check the box near the bottom that says **License Not Provided**. For reason choose **Landowner Hunt own Land**.

Q: When I begin to register an animal, why do I have to sign in again?


A: The system will timeout after one hour of inactivity, and you will have to sign in.
