PURPOSE

The proposed removal of Henderson Pond from the State Heritage Fish Waters list is being undertaken as one contingency to support conservation of Bald Mountain Pond charr. Removal from the State Heritage Fish Waters list is required by statute for the Department to transfer charr from Bald Mountain Pond to Henderson Pond. Amend Chapter 1A by removing this water from the State Heritage Fish Waters list.

PURPOSE

Though Round Pond has suitable water quality for the survival of brook trout, the lack of tributaries and suitable spawning habitat has prevented the establishment of a brook trout population. Though the Department undertook an experimental brook trout stocking in 1962, that population failed to persist due to lack of recruitment. The initial sampling conducted in 1960 yielded no brook trout. Subsequent surveys conducted in 1977, 1999, and 2017 also captured no brook trout. This proposal would remove Round Pond from the Heritage List.

Round Pond was proposed for the initial Heritage B List based upon outdated information contained in the SAS Lake Inventory file. The SAS file has been corrected since the last sampling event.

Round Pond is located in Baxter State Park and will still be regulated under the "BAXTER STATE PARK WATERS" special which includes CI, S-4, and the prohibition of the use of motorboats or outboard motors. Therefore, the special regulation for Round Pond can be removed from the lawbook without impacting the current regulations at Round Pond.

REGULATION CHANGE DESCRIPTION

Amend Chapter 1A by removing this water from the State Heritage Fish Waters list (no change to current regulations). If approved, this water would be removed from the State Heritage Fish Waters list effective October 1, 2018.

PURPOSE

Crescent Pond is proposed to be removed from the State Heritage Fish List to increase the suite of options available to conserve the lake whitefish population. Lake whitefish are designated as a Species of Special Concern in Maine and have declined considerably in range and number. Whitefish populations only exist in 45 waters in Maine, and many of those populations are threatened, including at Crescent Pond. Smelt were introduced into Crescent Pond in 1980 and have become so abundant that they are severely limiting lake whitefish recruitment. In 2000, lake trout from Allagash Lake (10 miles downstream) were transferred into Crescent Pond and indications are that those lake trout applied enough predatory pressure on smelt to reduce competition between smelt and lake whitefish. Spawning habitat is limited for lake trout, and to our knowledge the fish that were transferred in 2000 have not successfully reproduced. Due to the lack of natural reproduction, the lake trout population has since declined, and the smelt population is high. The possibility of another transfer of lake trout (from Allagash Lake) to control the smelt population will be explored through a formal stocking proposal consistent with department policy section H4. Policies for Stocking. Crescent Pond has never been stocked with brook trout and the native population contained therein is robust. No regulations changes are proposed, and current management goals and objectives for brook trout will remain.
