Proposed change to North Region General Law:

TERMINAL GEAR

NORTH REGION

Use or possession of live fish as bait is PROHIBITED. The use of all other legal forms of bait (including worms, and dead baitfish/dead smelts), artificial lures, and artificial flies is permitted.

SOUTH REGION

Use of all legal forms of bait (including live baitfish/live smelts), artificial lures, and flies is PERMITTED.

SEASONS

LAKES & PONDS

NORTH REGION

- From April 1 to September 30: Open to open water fishing, under general law bag and length limits. The use of all legal forms of bait, artificial lures, and artificial flies are permitted.
- · From October 1 to March 31: Closed to all fishing.

SOUTH REGION

 From January 1 to December 31: Open to ice and open water fishing, under general law bag and length limits. The use of all legal forms of bait, artificial lures, and artificial flies are permitted.

RIVERS, STREAMS, & BROOKS

NORTH & SOUTH REGIONS

- From April 1 to August 15: Open to open water fishing, under general law bag and length limits. The use of all legalforms of bait, artificial lures, and artificial flies are permitted.
- From August 16 to September 30: Open to open water fishing using artificial lures or flies only. General law length and bag limits apply, except daily bag limit one landlocked salmon and one brook trout.
- · From October 1 to March 31: Closed to all fishing.

Proposed addition of new S-code:

S-11: The use and possession of live baitfish/live smelts is permitted.
