

Proposed change to North Region General Law:

TERMINAL GEAR

NORTH REGION

Use or possession of live fish as bait is PROHIBITED. The use of all other legal forms of bait (including worms, and dead baitfish/dead smelts), artificial lures, and artificial flies is permitted.

SOUTH REGION

Use of all legal forms of bait (including live baitfish/live smelts), artificial lures, and flies is PERMITTED.

SEASONS

LAKES & PONDS

NORTH REGION

- **From April 1 to September 30:** Open to open water fishing, ~~under general law bag and length limits. The use of all legal forms of bait, artificial lures, and artificial flies are permitted.~~
- **From October 1 to March 31:** Closed to all fishing.

SOUTH REGION

- **From January 1 to December 31:** Open to ice and open water fishing, ~~under general law bag and length limits. The use of all legal forms of bait, artificial lures, and artificial flies are permitted.~~

RIVERS, STREAMS, & BROOKS

NORTH & SOUTH REGIONS

- **From April 1 to August 15:** Open to open water fishing, ~~under general law bag and length limits. The use of all legal forms of bait, artificial lures, and artificial flies are permitted.~~
- **From August 16 to September 30:** Open to open water fishing using artificial lures or flies only. General law length and bag limits apply, except daily bag limit one landlocked salmon and one brook trout.
- **From October 1 to March 31:** Closed to all fishing.

Proposed addition of new S-code:

S-11: The use and possession of live baitfish/live smelts is permitted.
