Non-Resident only will also need to print blank finger print cards to take to the appointment location, through https://www.fbi.gov/file-repository/standard-fingerprint-form-fd-258-1.pdf/view. After having finger prints taken, the applicant will need to wait 30 days before submitting completed application to the Department.
