Little Greely Pond is located west of Quill Hill. It has a short outlet which flows south into Greely Pond.


Many suckers and minnows compete with the brook trout population in Little Greely Pond. Natural reproduction is limited to a few areas along the shore and in the outlet, so annual stockings are necessary to provide trout fishing.

Little Greely Pond is reached by foot on an old woods road located near the outlet of Greely Pond. The use of live fish as bait is prohibited.
