Joe Pond is a typical bog pond with dense shoreline vegetation and sphagnum moss growing to the waters edge. No fish were captured during the original biological survey, but local sportsmen have reported a small number of small chain pickerel. The water of Joe Pond is very acidic and may account for the lack of fish.
