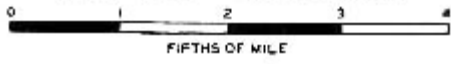

## Physical Characteristics

Area - 712 acres

Maximum depth - 27 feet

Principal fisheries: Smallmouth bass, white perch, chain pickerel

The physical characteristics of Pattee Pond best suit warmwater sport fish species. A low number of brown trout can survive to provide a limited coldwater sport fishery. Brown trout are stocked infrequently when unscheduled hatchery fish are available.

The abundance of white and yellow perch makes Pattee Pond an ideal place to introduce kids to the sport of fishing because of the 'fast' action.

Access to Pattee Pond is via a private campground located off the Pattee Pond Road where a small fee is charged to launch a boat.
