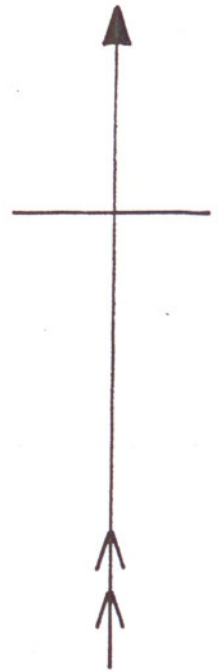
Angler access is restricted to permissive trespass along a dirt road on the east shore.
