Chair's **Message**



The InforME legislation, created in 1998, introduced a concept of digital government that was largely unfamiliar at the time, both in Maine and across the nation. As we mark the completion of 2024, it is clear the initiative has evolved far beyond expectations; InforME is a cornerstone of Maine's digital government, providing services that are now relied upon by thousands of Mainers every day.

InforME, through the Maine.gov portal and its partnership with Tyler Technologies, continues to expand and innovate, providing new services and improving existing ones. In 2024, 20 new services and websites were launched, making it easier for residents, business owners, and visitors to interact with government entities.

One of the new services that had significant impact is the Maine Healthy Beaches service. This service provides a way for testing laboratories and lab technicians to provide water testing data sampled from saltwater beaches across Maine. This data is then reported in real-time to the public through an interactive website, and visitors can receive text and email notifications about levels of bacteria found in the samples. Visited more than 35,000 times in 2024, this website helps to keep the public informed and safe.

This new service joins our ever-expanding suite of over 200 online offerings – offerings that we consistently reassess to make sure they deliver meaningful user experiences. InforME deployed 52 service enhancements to existing services in 2024 driven by user feedback, legislative changes, or by evolving agency needs. Examples include significant modifications to the Maine Open Burn Permit request service and the suite of corporate services offered through Maine's Bureau of Corporations, Elections, and Commissions.

InforME's work has gained national attention. In 2024, Maine.gov and its services were recognized with three national honors, as well as being ranked an A- in the

national Digital States Survey conducted by the Center for Digital Government.

InforME, through partnership with our state and local agencies, continues to expand digital government in Maine at the state, county, and municipal level. In our 26th year, InforME will finalize our strategic plan to align with the State of Maine's service and technology goals. This strategic plan will call for new ways to engage with constituents, continued modernization of our technology, and improved access to services.

I am excited to be a part of the evolution of InforME as we strive to enhance the digital government experience for all Mainers, improving efficiency, and expanding access to vital services. I would like to thank all the people that contribute to InforME's digital government success including the InforME Board members, Tyler Technologies network manager staff, participating government employees, and, of course, the Maine constituents who continue to shape and benefit from this evolving digital government platform.

As we look forward to more innovations in 2025, InforME's journey remains a true collaboration between government and technology, aimed at creating a more connected and efficient Maine.

CHAIR'S MESSAGE

2024 - A Year of Success

Maine.gov, powered by InforME, serves as a comprehensive digital gateway for the citizens of Maine, providing convenient, one-stop access to state and local services. InforME's self-funded initiative began with the passage of legislation in 1997, which led to the creation of Maine.gov in 1999. 26 years later, InforME continues to innovate in delivering seamless digital government services.

Key Milestones of 2024

- 61.7 million visits to Maine.gov content
- 1.795 million credit card payments processed, including:
 - 313,000 auto registration renewals
 - 253,000 hunting and fishing license purchase payments
 - 130,000 professional licensing transactions
- 2.02 million subscriber account transactions (for services like criminal record requests, annual report filings, and driver record checks)
- A total of \$270 million in revenue securely collected across 200+ services offered by InforME for state, local, and county partners
- 72 new sites and service enhancements launched, including:
 - A new clean election contributions service for the City of Portland
 - Restitution fee payments for the Department of Corrections
 - Outdoor services including moose and deer permit lotteries, ATV and snowmobile registration renewal, and game tagging and registration


Looking Ahead to 2025

In the coming year, InforME will continue to expand state and local government services and information by leveraging platform technologies such as the Engagement Builder platform and the content management system.

Additionally, InforME is partnering with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to create an outdoors mobile app. This app will have several exciting features including offline mapping capabilities, one-click payments for licenses, and links to rules, laws, and season and bag limit details. With the deployment of this and several other new services, websites, and initiatives in 2025, InforME is looking forward to another year of success.








New and Enhanced Services

Bureau of Motor Vehicles

Plate Reservation // May 2024

A standalone service which allows vehicle registrants in the state of Maine to reserve their existing license plate number prior to transition of the new plate design, beginning in May 2025. The application leverages the existing Rapid Renewal service to create an online reservation solution for all registrants, not just those who renew using Rapid Renewal. \$25 per plate reservation.



Health & Human Services

Childcare Scholarship Application // June 2024

An application used internally by The Office of Child

and Family Services to create and track scholarship payments made to childcare workers. No Fee.

Economic and Community Development

Co-Working Grant Application // February 2024

Allows existing or prospective businesses and organizations that operate a collaborative workspace to apply for one-time grant funding to support coworking development. No Fee.

Corrections

Restitution Fee Payments // March 2024

Allows individuals to view outstanding balances for restitution and/or supervision fees and submit payment towards their current amount due. Various Fees.

Economic and Community Development

Recovery and Resiliency Grant Application // May 2024

Allows businesses and nonprofit organizations impacted by 3 different winter storms between 2023 and 2024 to apply for one-time grant funding specifically for recovery, rebuilding and investments in infrastructure. No Fee.

City of Portland

Clean Elections Contributions Service // September 2024

Allows registered voters and residents in the City of Portland to make contributions to candidates seeking Maine Clean Election funding. Various Fees based on Donation Amount.

WIC Order Form // October 2024

An online ordering form that allows individuals to submit their WIC formula requests and the specific details regarding those requests, directly to the agency. No Fee.


