Chair's Message



As I reflect on the past year serving as Chair of the InforME Board, I am proud of the continued growth and measurable impact of this public-private partnership. In 2025, InforME launched **10 new online services**, completed **9 new website implementations and redesigns**, and delivered **58 service enhancements** across our portfolio. Each of these efforts strengthens the way Maine citizens, businesses, municipalities, and state agencies access government online.

Through Maine.gov, we welcomed **40,802,488 visits** over the past year. This sustained engagement reflects the public's reliance on secure, accessible, and user-friendly digital government services.

In 2025, the Board also adopted a new two-year strategic plan that will guide InforME's direction through 2027. This plan establishes three primary goals:

- **Promote the opportunities and benefits of Maine digital government services** to both citizens and businesses.
- **Identify opportunities and develop strategies to streamline and improve the overall citizen experience** in a way that serves all Mainers.
- **Explore opportunities for collaboration between the InforME Board and the InforME Network** to strengthen alignment, innovation, and shared success.

This strategic framework reinforces InforME's commitment not only to expanding services, but to improving how those services are experienced and delivered.

State of Maine agencies continue to prioritize modern, mobile-first website experiences, and InforME's enterprise content management system remains a cornerstone of that effort. The nine website launches and redesigns completed this year represent a continued investment in usability, accessibility, and streamlined communication.

Behind every successful deployment is a strong and responsive support structure. In 2025, the InforME service desk resolved **25,791 customer support tickets**, ensuring that users and agency partners receive timely and effective assistance.

It remains a privilege to serve as Board Chair. As InforME advances further into its third decade of digital government leadership, we remain focused on innovation, security, accessibility, and service excellence for the people of Maine.

2025 - A Year of Success

InforME develops and manages Maine.gov as a gateway to State of Maine information and online services. For more than two decades, InforME has combined advanced technology with thoughtful design to deliver convenient, secure, and accessible digital services to citizens, businesses, municipalities, and state agencies.

InforME Milestones – 2025

Today, hundreds of state and local entities rely on InforME to deliver high-demand digital services. In 2025 alone:

- **9 new services** were launched
- **9 agency websites** were fully designed or redesigned
- **58 service enhancements** were implemented
- **40,802,488 visits** were recorded on Maine.gov
- **25,791 service desk tickets** were resolved

A key driver of this year's rapid service deployment was **Engagement Builder**, InforME's form and workflow development platform. Engagement Builder provided significant speed-to-market advantages, enabling the team to launch **6 of the 9 new services introduced in 2025**. By leveraging reusable components, secure payment integrations, and streamlined approval workflows, agencies were able to move from concept to production more quickly while maintaining strong standards for accessibility, usability, and data security.

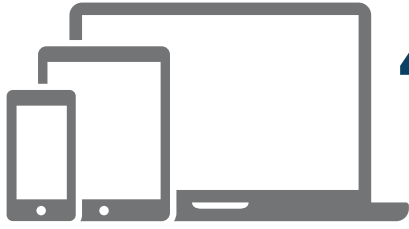
A major highlight of the year was the launch of the innovative **Maine Outdoors mobile app**, developed in partnership with the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries & Wildlife. The app, available on the Appstore and Play Store, enables users to purchase and store hunting and fishing licenses and permits, access regulations and season information, explore interactive maps, and locate places to hunt, fish, and recreate across Maine.

Designed with offline capabilities to support users in remote outdoor settings, the app expands access to digital government services beyond the desktop and into the field. Since its launch, the Maine Outdoors app has been downloaded **more than 25,000 times**, demonstrating strong adoption within Maine's outdoor community.

These milestones reflect both continued growth and ongoing refinement of existing systems to improve user experience and agency efficiency. Website redesigns strengthened accessibility and mobile responsiveness, while service enhancements improved reporting capabilities, payment processing, and backend integrations that support agency operations.

InforME remains focused on delivering scalable enterprise solutions that allow agencies to bring new programs online quickly and adapt to evolving public needs.
