You will be able to use the video to send to any prospective employer you like. We can use a green screen and customize your background, so please do not wear anything green! Ideally, wear a solid colored shirt that we can put a mic on.

Below is a table of 7 categories for you to choose from. Pick as many categories as you wish to put in your pitch. If it helps, picture yourself in the kind of career you are applying for and tailor your answers to that career.
