

How to Become a Registered Sponsor of Apprenticeship

1. Business/Potential Apprenticeship Sponsor expresses an interest in apprenticeship training.

2. Apprenticeship Staff assists business in completing 2-page registration form.

- a. Business identifies occupation and if available, provides apprenticeship staff with job description
- b. Sample Schedule of Work created by apprenticeship staff
- c. Related Technical Instruction (classroom training) discussed and identified
- 3. Business submits completed registration form and Schedule of Work to Maine Apprenticeship Program (MAP).
- 4. MAP staff finalize apprenticeship standards for business approval.
- 5. Business signs off on paperwork and sends to MAP.
- 6. MAP sends to Maine Apprenticeship Council for review and approval.

7. Council has 10 business days to review packet and ask questions or provide approval.

8. Once approved Business becomes a registered sponsor of apprenticeship.
