ORDERS

On motion of Representative CHAPMAN of Brooksville, the following Joint Order: (H.P. 1358)

ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that Bill, "An Act To Authorize Tribal Gaming," H.P. 838, L.D. 1201, and all its accompanying papers, be recalled from the legislative files to the House.

READ.

Pursuant to Joint Rule 404, this Joint Order required the affirmative vote of two-thirds of those present for **PASSAGE**.

The SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes the Representative from Brooksville, Representative Chapman, and inquires as to his Point of Order; inquires as to why he rises.

Representative **CHAPMAN**: I'm interested in a roll call, and I'm wondering if this is the time to request it.

The SPEAKER: The Chair would answer in the negative. The vote is open now. Once the Chair closes the vote, but before the Chair announces the vote, the Representative may rise and request a roll call.
