#### Senate at Ease

Senate called to order by the President.

The Chair laid before the Senate the Tabled and Today Assigned matter:

RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Protect State Parks
H.P. 176 L.D. 228
(C "A" H-92)

Tabled — May 20, 1993, by Senator ESTY of Cumberland.

Pending — Motion by Same Senator to RECEDE and CONCLIR

(In Senate, April 8, 1993, PASSED TO BE ENGROSSED AS AMENDED BY COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-92), in concurrence.)

(In House, May 19, 1993, PASSED TO BE ENGROSSED AS AMENDED BY COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-92) AS AMENDED BY HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" (H-360) thereto, in NON-CONCURRENCE.)

Senator **ESTY** of Cumberland requested and received leave of the Senate to withdraw his motion to **RECEDE** and **CONCUR**.

On motion by Senator **BERUBE** of Androscoggin, the Senate **RECEDED** from its action whereby this Bill was **PASSED TO BE ENGROSSED AS AMENDED**.

On further motion by same Senator, the Senate RECEDED from its action whereby it ADOPTED Committee Amendment "A" (H-92), in concurrence.

House Amendment "A" (H-360 READ.

On motion by Senator **BERUBE** of Androscoggin, House Amendment "A" (H-360) to Committee Amendment "A" (H-92) **INDEFINITELY POSTPONED** in **NON-CONCURRENCE**.

On further motion by same Senator, Senate Amendment "A" (S-185) to Committee Amendment "A" (H-92)  $\pmb{READ}$ 

THE PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Senator from Androscoggin, Senator Berube.

Senator BERUBE: Thank you Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate. This is an attachment to the Bill, which is a Constitutional referendum question, which would prohibit the sale of State parks and historic site lands unless the proceeds were then used to purchase or acquire additional land for State parks or historic sites. The amendment which came from the other body which we just removed would have allowed 4/5 or 80% of the legislature to override a Department's request to do otherwise. This amendment that we have attached would bring it down to the regular 2/3 requirement if that were the case. I hope you will support the amendment. Thank you.

On further motion by same Senator, Senate Amendment "A" (S-185) to Committee Amendment "A" (H-92)  $\pmb{ADOPTED}.$ 

Committee Amendment "A" (H-92) As Amended by Senate Amendment "A" (S-185) thereto, **ADOPTED** in **NON-CONCURRENCE**.
