## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to restore Portland Bridge.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. That the County Commissioners for the Coun-  
2 ty of Cumberland be, and they are hereby, directed to re-  
3 store in the City of Portland a bridge of steel or other ma-  
4 terial over and across Commercial Street from York Street,  
5 on Brackett Street, to the draw on Portland Bridge, with  
6 suitable approaches thereto, using so much of the highway  
7 and approaches to said Portland Bridge as may be neces-  
8 sary. Said bridge shall be built of such width and materials  
9 and in such manner as the County Commissioners shall  
10 determine that the interests of the public will best be sub-  
11 served. Said bridge when completed shall be suitable for  
12 all purposes of ordinary travel between the cities of Port-  
13 land and South Portland.
