The SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes the Representative from Lewiston, Representative Handy.

Representative HANDY: Mr. Speaker and Members of the House: I move acceptance of the Unanimous Committee Report.

This Bill and the Committee Amendment establishes a procedure for setting speed limits on the campuses of the University of Maine System. It also contains a provision guaranteeing each citizen of Maine the adequate opportunity to bring his or her concerns to the Board of Trustees through procedures to be established by the Board. These procedures might include, for example, appearances at public hearings, at committee meetings, or before the full Board of Trustees with full adequate public notice.

The trustees make many decisions of wide public interest and it is only appropriate that citizen access to the board be assured by statute rather than simply by the Board of Trustees policy.

Subsequently, the Committee Report was accepted, the bill read once.

Committee Amendment "A" (S-80) was read by the Clerk and adopted and the Bill assigned for second reading Monday, April 29, 1991.
