Please describe the scope of services GPCOG provided under the Cooperative Agreements with MaineDOT and MTA in those years.

The GPCOG provides four main services under the Cooperative Agreements with MaineDOT and the Maine Turnpike Authority:

- Program Administration: Manage GoMaine program elements;
- Vanpool Program Management: Manage vanpool program;
- Ridesharing Technology: Utilize, maintain and improve ridesharing system and supporting technologies; and
- Outreach/Education/Marketing: Conduct commuter and employer outreach, education and marketing

The Maine Turnpike authority funds the first two services, Program Administration and Vanpool Program Management, and the MaineDOT funds the Ridesharing Technology and Outreach/Education/Marketing services.

These tasks are described in more detail in the attached contract.
