Emergency Fire Dispatch Certification Course

EFD Certification Course

The Emergency Fire Dispatcher (EFD) through the use of the FPDS[™] brings the science of structured call processing to the fire-rescue field. Completion of this course provides students with confidence to begin using the protocol on-line in the busiest of communication centers. Classes use hands-on teaching, class participation, simulated and actual calls, and feedback to prepare the students for work in a communication center.

Pre-Requisites and Information:

The EFD course is open to all applicants that read and write at a high school graduate or GED level. Initial certification requires the applicant complete an approved EFD course and complete a 50 question written exam at the end of the course with a minimum 80% score. If the applicant does not successfully pass the initial exam, retests are available by phone for a \$30 fee.

Registration includes:

- EFD Course Manual
- Certification fee and testing with the National Academy of EFD
- 8 hours of CDE that can be used towards recertification in another discipline

Successful attendees receive:

- 2 year subscription to the National Journal of Emergency Dispatch
- Academy insignia patch and pocket membership card

The EFD Course is open to all applicants 18 years or older with a high school or equivalent degree. The intensive three day courses cover:
