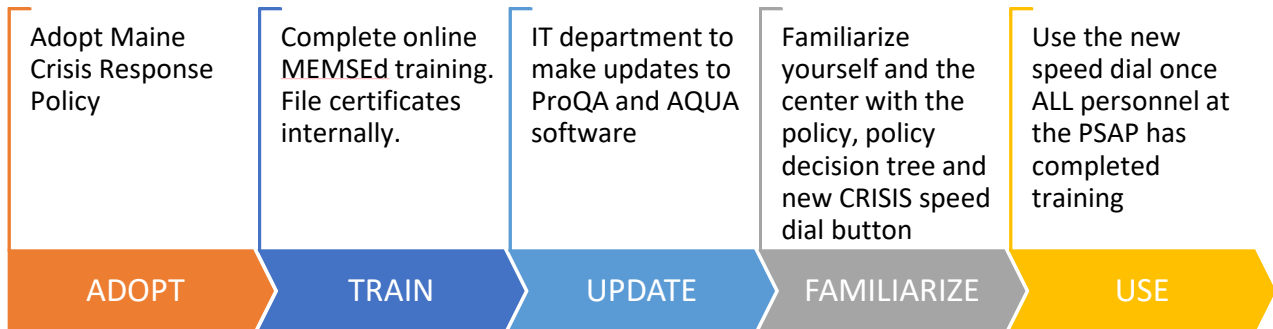
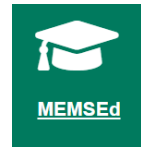


# Maine Crisis Response Policy Implementation Guidance



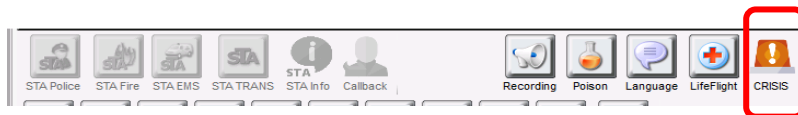
The policy document and Decision Tree are available to view or download from the [Maine ESCB Policies webpage](#). PSAPs are not required but are encouraged to adopt the policy. **A PSAP must adopt and implement the policy before staff use the CRISIS transfer option.**

Policy implementation includes all PSAP staff completing an online training available in the [Maine EMS Education \(MEMSEd\) portal](#). Anyone with an existing Maine EMS license has a user account in MEMSEd with the same login credentials as the Maine EMS eLicensing portal. PSAPs must work with their IT staff to update Paramount ProQA Software to Version 14.0.22: Build 5.1.1.46 or later and Update AQUA to version 7.1.1.4. Click here for [Priority Dispatch's software support, available 24/7](#). Within the software access Share Point file are release notes and the agency impact form. This update includes significant changes to Protocol 25. Users will find existing and upcoming IAED training at the Online College through their member portal at [www.emergencydispatch.org](http://www.emergencydispatch.org).

Implementing the policy requires PSAP leaders and Telecommunicators to be familiar with the Policy, how to use the Decision Tree, and the new CRISIS quick transfer icon in the 9-1-1 software. Familiarity is obtained through exposure and practice. Please let the [ESCB](#) or [Maine EMS](#) support staff know if you have an idea on how we can assist with this at your agency.
