Attached please find the November 2010 MCILS Operation Report for your review and our discussion at the upcoming Commission meeting on December 14, 2010.

In the month of November:

- The number of rostered attorney rose to 418 and firms represented rose to 358.
- 2,354 new cases were opened in the DefenderData system.
- 2,153 vouchers were submitted, with 1,939 paid electronically totaling \$692,881.33.
- The number of paper vouchers submitted and paid decreased by 40% to 44 at a total amount of \$45,517.11.
- Combined, there were 1,983 electronic and paper vouchers paid totaling \$738,398.44. The average amount per voucher in November went down from \$394.81 to \$372.36.

You may notice that the Revenue Account has a larger balance than is typical for month end. The Executive Director made the decision to pay the Somerset County and DefenderData contracts from our All Other Account instead of the Revenue account in November because the journal transfer from the Judicial Branch for revenue collected for counsel reimbursements was late. However, we now have the ability to pay electronic vouchers from the Revenue Account and will be spending it down in that manner this month to make up the difference.

We are pleased to report that we hired Christina Tripp-Maynard as the financial screener for York County Courts. Tina previously held this position before it was transferred from the Judicial Branch, and we are very happy to have her working with us. We have also hired Bruce Stahl to fill the Portland screener position. He will begin training with our other financial screeners next week and assume his screening responsibilities in Portland the week of December 20. Now that we finally have a full staff of screeners, we hope to see our collections for counsel reimbursements continue to increase in the coming months.
