



Lawyer of the Day Minimum Standards Training

When: April 11, 2024 from 8:30AM-3:30PM

Summary: In this training, participants will learn about how to serve as lawyer of the day (LOD) for both in-custody and walk-in proceedings. Participants will learn about LODW and LODC procedure; bail, including the different types and conditions of bail, how to make winning bail arguments, and bail procedure; challenging probable cause; plea negotiations; assignment of counsel; and 7-day counsel review hearings. The training satisfies the initial minimum training requirements for assigned counsel to be eligible for LOD assignments under Chapter 3 of the Commission Rules.

Eligibility: Only open to attorneys who are eligible to receive MCILS case assignments.
