

Strengthening the Sixth in Maine: Building Client and Courtroom Skills that Scale

Summary: MCILS and the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers (NACDL) have partnered to sponsor this two-day training for a limited number of rostered attorneys. The training will include lectures and breakout sessions for practical exercises covering topics such as: client interviewing, Fourth Amendment issues, objections and evidence, cross examination and impeachment, preparing for trial, storytelling, and ethics. The faculty includes experts in criminal defense from across the country and experienced Maine attorneys.

Eligibility: To attend this training, you must be eligible to accept MCILS criminal case assignments, have pending MCILS criminal cases, and have 5 years or less of criminal defense experience. You must also be available to attend both days of training in full in-person.
