**Board of Licensure in Medicine  
Procedural Rules for April 12, 2022**

1. Board staff have established the Zoom meeting to allow public observation only. In the event that the Board enters an executive session, the meeting will remain live on Zoom, but the camera and microphone will be turned off until the Board resumes a public session of the meeting.
2. The Board meeting will be conducted with Board members displayed visually in the Boardroom.
3. For Board members and Board staff who are participating in the meeting here are some helpful hints:
  - All phones/cell phones should be on mute at this time. Thank you.
  - If anyone requires a bathroom break, please speak up and request a break in the meeting.
  - We will be conducting a ½ hour lunch break during the meeting, commencing at 12:00 p.m. The meeting will remain “live” on Zoom during that time. However, all lines will be muted, and the camera will be turned off.
4. Members of the public who are attending the meeting in person are cautioned not to speak during the meeting as it may be picked up by the microphone and unnecessarily disrupt the meeting and/or ability of the public accessing the meeting virtually to hear the Board members.
5. Members of the public who are attending the meeting in person are cautioned not to approach the Board members or to engage them in discussion. Board members are here today to conduct the business of the Board, and the Board staff is here today to support the Board in conducting its business.
6. Members of the public who are attending in person and are having difficulty hearing the discussion should log onto the Zoom meeting using their personal devices and listen using headphones.

7. Access to the Board staff offices is restricted to Board staff and Board members.
8. The Board, Board staff, and members of the public who are present in person for today's meeting are reminded of the CDC Guidelines regarding hand washing and maintaining appropriate social distancing. Anyone who is fully vaccinated does not have to mask. Anyone who wishes to mask may do so without comment or question.
9. The meeting today will follow (as best as possible) the agenda, which will consist of:
  - i. Licensure Matters;
  - ii. Complaints and Investigations;
  - iii. Adjudicatory Hearing;
  - iv. Public Agenda; and
  - v. Adjournment.
