

Continuing Medical Education Taken in Other Countries

POLICY: It is the policy of the Board of Licensure in Medicine that category 1 CME credits from countries other than the United States will be accepted to meet active license renewal requirements if a formal reciprocal agreement exists between that country and the Accreditation Council for Medical Education of the American Medical Association.

On January 12, 1999 the Board reaffirmed this policy of the Board. The Board received assurance from Maine Medical Association that a reciprocal agreement exists between the American Medical Association's Committee on Continuing Medical Education and the Committee on Accreditation of Canadian Medical Schools (CACMS) regarding CME.
